## What is Kazin 60+?

Kazin 60+ is a fun, creative and learning outcomes driven project, based on the theatre world. In a group setting, six (6) theatre practitioners and actors will lead six (6) groups, located in different regions around Malta, towards achieving new theatrical experiences. Guest tutors will also be invited to some of the sessions with the intention of sharing their expertise in the Arts and Performance field. This project will be fun – full of theatre games, improvisations, movement, singing, reading and learning of possible small scenes and texts. This creative space will be shared and enjoyed with like-minded persons from different walks of life, allowing the opportunity to develop new found friendships.

From one session to another the new group of actors will gain experience as well as confidence, which can help with being on stage, delivering a speech but also in one's daily life. Participants will be able to learn the skill of acting but also to work behind the scenes if they prefer it.

As a bonus, research in wellbeing shows that remaining creative, learning new skills and taking on new challenges in the later years is an all round win-win situation, and has proven to be beneficial on a physical and psychological level.

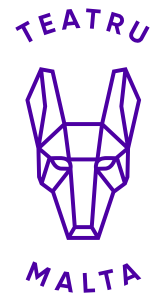
## Who are we looking for?
