CALL FOR ACTORS

Teatru Malta is inviting actors to work with its cohort of emerging directors on a new artistic project exploring plays from across Europe and the Mediterranean.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

In celebration of Teatru Malta's 10th anniversary, our upcoming artistic initiative will feature a curated programme of 10 plays from around Europe and the Mediterranean, never before staged in Malta. These works will be translated and performed for the first time in Maltese, offering audiences an opportunity to watch a series of important works from theatre traditions under-represented on our stages.

Led by 10 emerging directors with the guidance and mentorship of the Teatru Malta Ensemble, the plays will be presented in a raw black-box theatre set-up in a series of double-bill performances throughout the year.

Selected actors will work with one of the 10 directors on rehearsals for one of the plays, before showcasing their work in a weekend of public performances.


WHAT WE'RE LOOKING FOR:


