What is Kazin60+?

Kazin60+ is a fun and creative project based on the theatre world, driven by learning outcomes. In a group setting, six (6) theatre practitioners and actors will lead six (6) groups, one per region across Malta and Gozo, towards achieving new theatrical experiences. Guest tutors will also be invited to some of the sessions with the intention of sharing their expertise in the Arts and Performance field.

This project will be fun - full of theatre games, improvisations, movement, singing, reading and learning of possible small scenes and texts. This creative space will be shared and enjoyed with like-minded persons from different walks of life, allowing the opportunity to develop newfound friendships.

From one session to another the new group of actors will gain experience as well as confidence, which can help with being on stage, delivering a speech but also in one's daily life. As they go along, participants will be able to learn new theatre skills as well as work behind the scenes, whatever they prefer.

We believe in projects like Kazin60+ because they are concrete proof that creativity, learning new skills, and taking on new challenges in the later years, together form an all-round win-win situation, and has proven to be beneficial on several levels, physically, psychologically, but also socially. WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?


We are looking for individuals to join Kazin60+ from all the different regions, where we would select a maximum of 25 per region (and therefore per group). You're in if:

PROGRAMME

The course will run from March – December 2025 with holidays during Public Holidays, festivities, and a summer break.

TIMELINE
